#Applicant/Owner to Note

A rural address post is a galvanized post with a black delineator attached at the top. Reflective numbers, indicating the rural number allocated to your property are attached to both sides of the delineator.

Your rural address post should be installed at a location easily visible from the road, adjacent to the driveway/access to your property. This is of particular assistance to emergency services.
